Children are continuing to learn Phase 3 phonic sounds, which are the sounds in the middle of words. This will help children to read and write a lot more words.

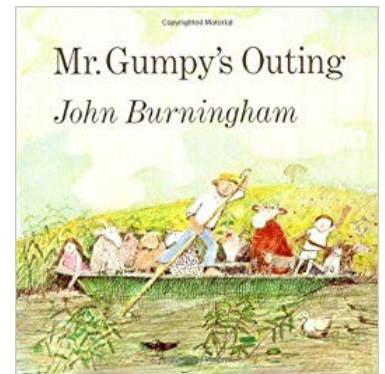
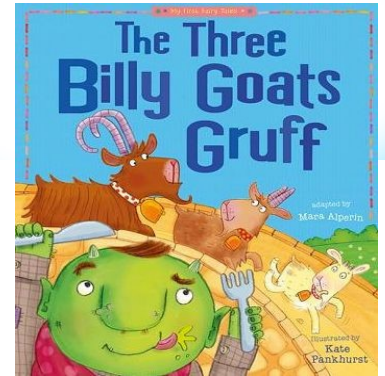
