Information for Parents and Guardians

HMRC Can Help Towards the Cost of Children's Summer Holiday Activities

HM Revenue and Customs (HMRC) is reminding working families in London that they can use Tax-Free Childcare to help pay for their childcare costs over the summer.

Parents and carers can check their eligibility and register for Tax-Free Childcare via GOV.UK. They can apply for an account at any time and start using it straight away. By depositing money into their accounts, families can benefit from the 20% top-up and use the money to pay for child-care costs when they need to, for example, during the summer holidays.
