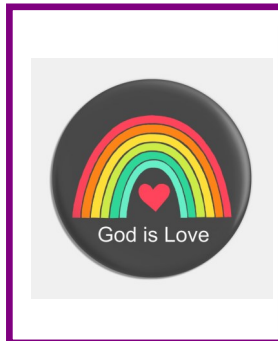

Place: In person at  Kitcat Terrace, Bow, London, E3 2SA

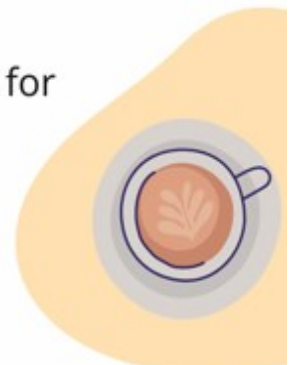
Kitcat Terrace is near to:
