There may be some tough decisions and I am

sure we will work it out together.

Dear Parents/Carers

Proposed Expansion of St Saviour's CE Primary School

I am writing concerning the Council's proposal for the expansion of St Saviour's and to provide an update following the earlier consultation with parents and school staff last term.

You may recall that the Council said it would make a final decision on whether to proceed with the expansion in the new year. In doing so it needed to consider the feedback from the school and wider community as well as the developing situation with the demand for school places in the Poplar area.

Having considered this information the Council has decided not to proceed with the expansion of St Saviour's at this time. The reason for this decision is because it is now evident that the demand for additional school places in Poplar is not increasing at the level previously expected. Therefore expanding St Saviour's at this time could create too many surplus places before they are needed.

I know that the decision not to expand St Saviour's at this time will be a disappointment to the whole school community, given the extensive work that has gone into preparing the plans to this point.

I am therefore very sorry to have to break this news to you at this time.

The Council still expects there to be increased demand for school places in Poplar in the future. Should this be the case it will revisit its plans for the expansion of St Saviour's at the earliest opportunity.
