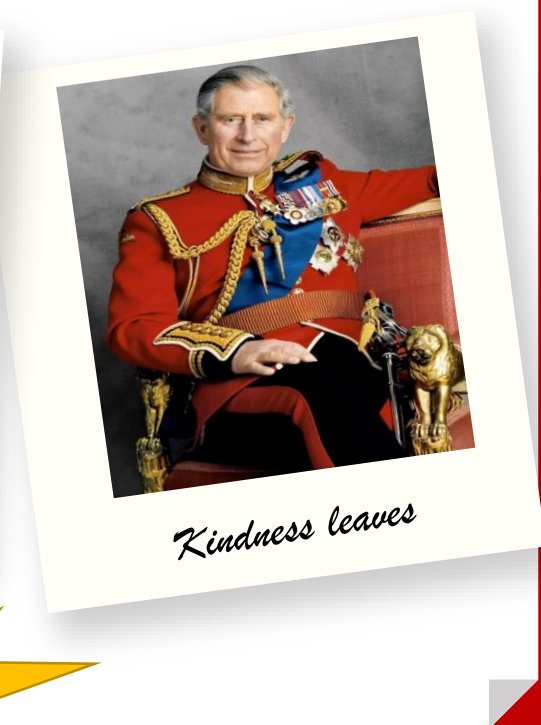

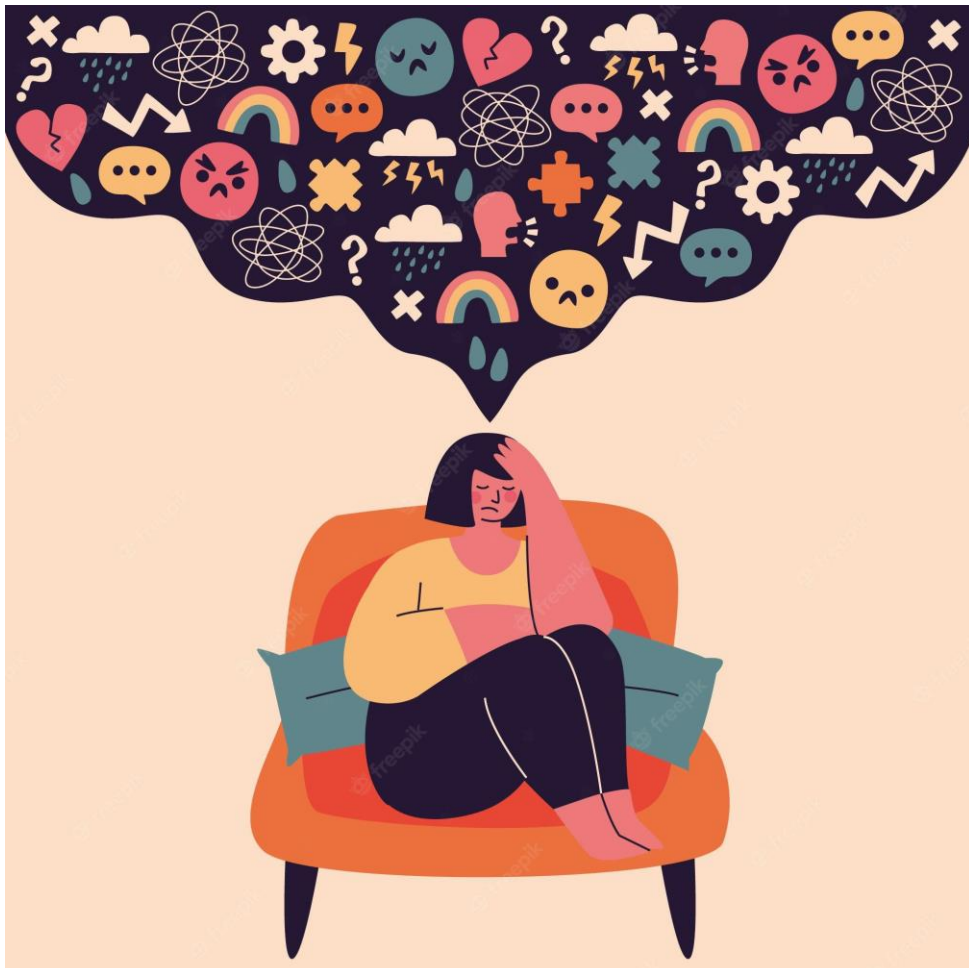
### Stars of the weeks
