Voluntary Aided School Contribution

As you would be aware, as a Voluntary Aided School we rely heavily on the support of our families and as part of our admission agreement we ask families for a £30 voluntary contribution towards the LDBS Maintenance fund.

We ask for these contributions during the first half term of every new academic year, September to July.

The contribution will need to be paid via ParentPay – please see Clare in the school office if you require further assistance on this.

The school has to pay the London Diocesan Board for Schools £30 per pupil per term regardless if we receive any contribution from our families, we ask for the £30 voluntary contribution per family and not per child.
