We seek to offer a fantastic musical education, free of charge, in a fun, friendly environment.

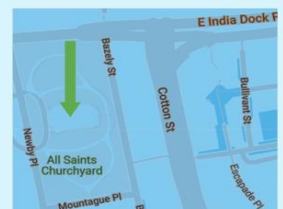
Services at All Saints
