In Understanding the World we are learning about Diwali, Bonfire night and Remembrance Day, with lots of opportunity to talk about what we celebrate, and how we celebrate with people who are special to us. Alongside our core text, we will also be exploring how to keep a healthy, balanced diet and hope to use our planting skills to grow some root vegetables.


Our R.E scheme for this half term focuses on the story of Christmas and this will build us up for our Christmas performance later in the term.

In maths, we will continue to learn how to recite numbers in order, and use this knowledge to count amounts, knowing that the last number represents the total in an amount. We will then recap on subitising and deepen our learning of repeats and repeating patterns.

Our Think Equal scheme has already had a very strong impact in Nursery as children continue to learn about their differences, similarities and emotions. This half term, we will begin to learn how to manage our emotions and consider the feelings of others.
