Welcome back after the holidays, I hope you all had a good break. We are looking forward to a new term and I hope the children are raring to go!

What are we learning this half term?

English

This half term the children will begin the term by writing a non-chronological report on The Romans. They will complete their own research and add their previous knowledge from their learning in History.

We will be using the text 'Journey', by Aaron Becker, to support our diary entry writing and writing in role.

We will continue reading Operation Gadget man during our shared reading and work in small groups for Guided Reading.

Please continue to support your child's reading at home as much as you can and encourage them to fill in their reading records.

Maths

This term, the children will learn how to add and subtract lengths and calculate the perimeter. To follow, we will start a unit of work on Fractions. We will order and compare unit and non-unit fractions before looking at fractions and equivalent fractions on a number line.

We will also revisit other areas of learning from both Y1 and Y2 in each session to make sure that the children are revising their Maths, as much as possible.

Science

This half term the children will continue their learning of Forces and Magnets, investigating what materials are magnetic and why some objects repel against each other.

We will then start our new topic on Plants by investigating what the flowering parts of a plant are, and what they do?

R.E.

We will be looking and learning about Christianity this term. Our learning in RE will look at the question, 'Why do Christians call the day Jesus died, 'Good Friday'? Children will learn what happens during Holy Week in church and how Christians feel about these events. We will conclude our learning, by looking at the significance of the three crosses.

History

During History, we will continue our learning about The Romans, focusing on the Roman invasion and how Britain changed under the Roman Rule.

Geography

In our Geography lessons, we will continue learning about the cities and countries of The U.K. and look at the topological patterns of the U.K. We will share all of our learning at the end of the topic and present it to the class.

Homework will be sent out on Thursdays and can now be accessed online. We will be using Century AI this term to support home learning, so please do not hesitate to ask if you have any questions. This term, homework will focus on learning times-tables and practicing weekly spellings.
